

# EADA Business School and TSH Talent Foundation agree to jointly promote initiatives aimed at achieving transformative, inclusive, and socially-driven education.

- The collaboration highlights the commitment of both institutions to fostering young talent development, with the aim of shaping the transformative leaders of the future and strengthening innovation ecosystems.
- As part of the agreement, the EADA-TSH Talent Foundation "Sustainability Changemaker Scholarship" has been launched—an initiative designed to facilitate access to business education through EADA Business School's International Master in Sustainable Business & Innovation.

**Barcelona, May, 7, 2025-** EADA Business School and <u>TSH Talent Foundation</u> - a nonprofit organisation established by the global hospitality brand The Social Hub - have signed an agreement aimed at promoting the development of young talent committed to sustainability, innovation, and social impact. This partnership reflects the commitment of both institutions to shaping the transformative leaders of the future and strengthening innovation ecosystems at both European and international levels.

The collaboration between EADA and TSH Talent Foundation seeks to create new opportunities for education, connection, and development for students and professionals from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds. As part of this alliance, the institutions plan to develop open educational platforms for the community, host high-level expert conferences, and create opportunities to connect EADA's ecosystem with The Social Hub's international network, which spans more than 21 dynamic European cities where their hotels are located.

The Social Hub created the TSH Talent Foundation in 2024, a standalone nonprofit registered in The Netherlands dedicated to empowering changemakers. It is funded via a pledge by the hybrid hospitality pioneer to distribute 1% of its annual turnover to the organisation, a first for the industry. The Foundation's activities began in September 2024 with a pan-European scholarship programme.

# Introducing the EADA – TSH Talent Foundation Sustainability Changemaker Scholarship

The beginning of this collaboration begins with the launch of the EADA-TSH Talent Foundation "Sustainability Changemaker Scholarship" (<a href="https://landings.eada.edu/en/scholarship/sustainability-changemaker">https://landings.eada.edu/en/scholarship/sustainability-changemaker</a>). This scholarship is designed to facilitate access to business education through EADA Business School's International Master in Sustainable Business & Innovation. A pioneering programme in Europe, it positioned EADA as one of the first business schools to place sustainability at the core of its educational approach.

Internationally recognized, the master's programme stands out for its strong focus on developing critical and strategic thinking skills—essential for leading transformation in both economic and social spheres.

The scholarship will cover full tuition for the programme, along with 10 months of accommodation at The Social Hub Barcelona. The recipient will also take part in an exclusive programme of workshops focused on personal and professional leadership development, including modules on self-awareness, communication, goal setting, well-being, and academic skills.
